

The perennials and shrubs listed on this set of slides provide either food, shelter, or breeding habitat for many native bees, birds, and butterflies.



Actaea 'Chocoholic' Bugbane

Location in Garden: Zone 3

Bloom Time: August - September

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 3 - 4' Spread: 2.5 - 3'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Good for Naturalizing

Colorful leaves and berries

Good cut flowers

Also known as Cimicifuga

Occasional Problems: Rust and leaf spot. Leaves may scorch in dry conditions.



### Arisaema triphyllum Jack-in-the-pulpit

**MINNESOTA NATIVE** 

Location in Garden: Zone 3 Bloom Time: April – June Preferred Soil: Medium to wet

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 1 - 3' Spread: 1 - 1.5'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Good for naturalizing
Good for use in rain gardens
Tolerates heavy shade, wet
soil, black walnut
Does not do well in clay soil





### **Astilbe**

Location in Garden: Zone 3

Bloom Time: June - July

Attracts: Bees, butterflies

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 2 - 3'

Spread: 2 - 3'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance

Deer and rabbit resistant

Tolerates multiple soils

Good cut flowers

**Occasional Problems:** Leaves may brown up during hot summers and dry periods





## Astilbe 'Amethyst'

Location in Garden: Zone 2 Bloom Time: June - July Attracts: Bees, butterflies

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 2 - 3' Spread: 2 - 3'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance

Deer and rabbit resistant

Tolerates multiple soils

Good cut flowers

**Occasional Problems:** Leaves may brown up during hot summers and dry periods





# Athyirum filix-femina

Lady fern

Location in Garden: Zone 3 Bloom Time: Nonflowering Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full

shade

Height: 2 - 5' Spread: 3 - 7'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance

Rabbit resistant

Tolerates more sun and dryness than most ferns

Shelter from wind to avoid tattered looking fronds

Divide in spring

## Athyirum niponicum 'Pictum' Japanese painted fern

Location in Garden: Zone 7 Bloom Time: Nonflowering Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 1 - 1.5' Spread: 1.5 - 2'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance Good for naturalizing Rabbit resistant Decorative foliage Divide in spring





Bergenia cordifolia

Pigsqueak

Location in Garden: Zone 3 Bloom Time: April - May Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade -Full shade

Height: 1 - 1.5' Spread: 1 - 1.5'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Good for ground cover Good for naturalizing Deer and rabbit resistant Tolerates multiple soils Good cut flowers and leaves Spreads slowly by rhizomes Remove spent flowering stems





### Dicentra luxuriant Bleeding heart

Location in Garden: Zone 1

Bloom Time: May Attracts: Butterflies

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade

Height: 1 - 1.5' Spread: 1 - 1.5'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Good for naturalizing

Rabbit resistant

Good cut flowers

Attractive foliage

Occasional Problems: Aphids, mildew, wilt, rust

**Remove** spent flowering stems to promote additional blooming.





## Geranium maculatum Wild geranium

MINNESOTA NATIVE

Location in Garden: Zone 4, 7

Bloom Time: May - June

Attracts: Butterflies

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 1 - 2'

Spread: 1 - 2'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Deer and rabbit resistant

Tolerates dry soil

Occasional Problems: Snails

and slugs





Heuchera sp. Coral bells

Location in Garden: Zone 7 Bloom Time: June - July Attracts: Bees, butterflies

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 1 - 2' Spread: 1 - 1.5'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Colorful foliage

Good for naturalizing

Wide variety of hybrid colors and sizes

**Remove** spend flowers to encourage additional blooming



### Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears'

Location in Garden: Zone 7 Bloom Time: July - August

Attracts: Hummingbirds, bees

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 0.5 - 1' Spread: 0.75 - 1'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance

Easy division in early spring

Tolerates heavy shade

Occasional Problems: Snails.

slugs, deer, viruses



### Hosta sp.

Location in Garden: Zone 3, 4, 7

Bloom Time: July - August

Attracts: Hummingbirds, bees

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full shade

Height: 0.5 - 2' Spread: 0.5 - 2'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance Decorative foliage Tolerates heavy shade

Occasional Problems: Snails,

slugs, deer, leaf spot





### Lamium maculatum Spotted deadnettle

Location in Garden: Zone 5, 7

Bloom Time: May - July

Attracts: Bees

Preferred Soil: Medium

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade - Full

shade

Height: .25 - .75'

Spread: 1 - 2'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Low maintenance

Colorful foliage

Deer and drought resistant

Tolerates heavy shade and dry soil

Occasional Problems: Aphids, slugs, leaf blight, leaf spots, crown rot in wet soils





# Polygonatum odoratum var. puriflorum Solomon's Seal

Location in Garden: Zone 7 Bloom Time: April – June

Attracts: Bees

Preferred Soil: Medium to wet

Preferred Sunlight: Part shade -Full shade

Height: 2 - 3' Spread: 0.75 - 1'

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Good for naturalizing
Tolerates multiple soils
Spreads by rhizomes

Fragrant flowers, attractive berries

Ornamental foliage

**Occasional Problems:** Slugs, snails, weevils, sawflies

TOXICITY: May cause discomfort if ingested by humans
